

## GRIMSAY LOCAL PRODUCE MARKET - STOCKING POLICY

The Grimsay local produce market is a small market that aims to showcase the best of our locally produced foods, arts and crafts. 'Local' includes all islands throughout the Uists and Benbecula, from Eriskay to Berneray.

Given the limited space available and the need to support local producers, artists and artisans, Grimsay Community Association will admit products based on the following scoring system.

1. FOOD PRODUCTS - vegetables, baking, preserves etc.		SCORE
1 point each	A. Grown / produced locally	
	B. Produced from local ingredients	
	C. Produced to a traditional, local recipe	
	<b>TOTAL</b> Must score at least 1 point to qualify	

2. OTHER PRODUCTS - arts, crafts etc.		SCORE
1 point each	A. Made locally	
	B. Designed locally	
	C. Made from local materials	
	D. On a local theme	
	<b>TOTAL</b> Must score at least 2 points to qualify	
Must also be	Well made	Y / N
And	Sellable *	Y / N

\* determined by a 4 week trial period and promoted as a new product

The Management Committee will administer and monitor this policy and is free to make exceptions to this policy at its own discretion. The decision of the Management Committee is final.

GCA will endeavour to make available for sale all goods accepted for sale through the market. However, due to the limited space available it may be necessary to reduce the range or volume of an individual trader's stock that is presented for sale from time to time.
